Dr. Troy Baird is Professor Emeritus in the Department of Biology at the University of Central Oklahoma. He taught courses in general biology and zoology, vertebrate zoology, animal behavior and herpetology for 30 years, retiring last year to pursue research on the evolution of social behavior, mating systems, communication, and predator avoidance. For over a decade, Dr. Baird's research has focused on combining detailed observations in the field with genetic-parentage studies to examine the relationship between behavior and fitness in Oklahoma collared lizards.
