### **Financial Benefits**

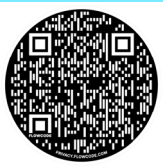
- Receive approximately \$1,000 per year, for up to two years, for professional memberships, conference attendance, professional development activity participation, and books/supplies from the Mathematics and Science Teacher Initiative (MSTI).
- Guaranteed paid experience working with K-12 students through the Teaching Fellows Scholarship Program; students can earn \$700 per month.
- Qualify for \$3,750 per year through the Federal TEACH Grant Program.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

- Be a junior community college transfer student in Fall 2023
- Interested in becoming a middle or high school mathematics teacher
- Minimum 3.3 community college GPA
- Must have taken the Calculus sequence and a lower division Differential Equations course and received a grade of C or better
