

California Basic Educational Skills Test (CBEST)



What is the CBEST?

The CBEST is designed to meet requirements to credentialing and employment for careers in the education field.

- **Reading:** Assess your ability to comprehend information presented in written passages, tables, and graphs.
- **Mathematics:** Assesses your ability to: (1) estimation, measurement, and statistical principles; (2) computation and problem solving; and (3) numerical and graphic relationships. Most of the questions are presented in word problems.
- **Writing:** Assesses your ability to write effectively. By responding to 2 topics. One topic asks you to analyze a given situation or statement; the other asks you to write about a specified personal experience.

Who Takes it?

In California, students must demonstrate proficiency in basic skills if any one of the following conditions applies to you:

- If you are applying for a teaching credential or services credential.
- If you are applying for Substitute Teaching Permit.
- If you are applying for admission to a Commission on Teaching and Credentialing (CTC)-accredited teacher preparation program.
- If you are applying for admission to a CTC - accredited services credential program.

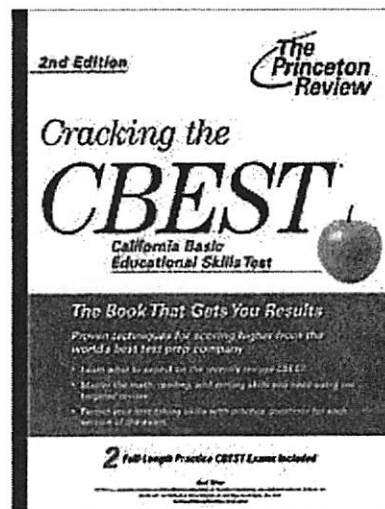
*You may take the CBEST only if you have earned, at minimum, a high school diploma, a GED, or the equivalent or if you are, or have been, a student taking courses for college credit pursuant to a career in education.
