

CALL FOR PROPOSALS

RIMI GRANT WRITING SUMMER TRAINING

The Research Infrastructure in Minority Institutions (RIMI) grant at Fresno State (<http://rimi.csufresno.edu>) seeks applications from faculty interested in honing their NIH grant writing skills to participate in a week-long summer training workshop May 23-27, 2011. NIH staff, local faculty and staff, and RIMI researchers will conduct morning training sessions outlining various stages of the NIH grant application process, followed by participants applying what they have learned in the afternoon sessions.

Workshop participants will receive a \$1000 stipend for their completion of the week-long training activities which will culminate in a draft proposal and a plan/timeline for submission to NIH. The summer training contributes to the overall goal of the RIMI grant to develop faculty and institutional capacity at Fresno State in biomedical and behavioral research.
